Brief Job Description

The pilot position is responsible for the safe operation of District aircraft as pilot in command while flying nighttime aerial spray missions in our Skyvan (SC-7) and Twin Otter (DHC-6) aircraft. The ideal candidate is a commercial, multi-engine instrument-rated pilot with a minimum of 1500 hours total time. Dual rated pilots are also encouraged to apply.

The successful candidate will be joining a dynamic team on the cutting-edge of innovative ideas. They will have an office on-site and work closely with the Chief Pilot.

- FAA Commercial Pilot Certificate for Airplane Multi-engine Land Rating; Instrument Rating; and/or Rotorcraft-Helicopter Rating; FAA Class II Medical Certificate.

- Must be able to read and understand chemical labeling instructions.
